


A Note from Our Pastor

Property Report, May, 2018

An awning was installed over the kitchen door by the same company who installed the new awning at the front door. This awning, as well as the new kitchen freezer, was provided by memorial funds for Steve Golembiewski.

We've had to apply tick insecticide to the playground grass already since a tick was found there. We always do an insecticide application to the park area two weeks prior to the combined service with Zoar as a precautionary measure. Ant season has returned and we need to make sure all crumbs, etc. are completely cleaned up on Sunday mornings to keep ants out of the lobby.

The sink leak in the lobby has been repaired We recently had our annual fire safety inspection. Simplex inspected our smoke detection system and pull stations and then activated an alarm to test our monitoring system. Everything worked as it should. Perrysburg Twp. Fire safety inspection also took place. Following that inspection, we needed to replace some emergency lighting batteries that failed during the test. These batteries last 8 – 10 years and have all been replaced once. We are now starting the second replacement cycle.

We recently patched our own LCM pothole that developed near the drain in the parking lot.

The furnace/air cond. unit that handles Connie's and Pastor's offices recently failed and Downey Heating replaced the control panel. All of our "new" furnaces are approaching 20 years old. We need to anticipate these maintenance costs becoming more common. We keep all the air filters changed on a regular basis but mechanical/electronic failures can happen anytime.

A broken water line in the Scout Building has been repaired and the water is turned on for use during preparation for the Rummage Sale.

The committee has not yet met to discuss light at the front of the church or rekeying the outside doors of the building.

We had only seven people show up for our Spring Cleanup on Thursday night May 10th. Not a very good turnout so much work still needs to be done.

Finance (Memorial) Committee may forward a proposal to Council to install a handrail at the front of the sanctuary to help elderly members up the steps to read or assist with communion. This would be a memorial for Steve Golembiewski as proposed by Donna.
